Call for Emerging Artists for JITN's 2019-20 season

Jazz in the Neighborhood is providing aspiring jazz musicians an opportunity to:

- perform on stage with professional jazz musicians, in particular at Jazz in the Neighborhood's Guaranteed Fair Wage Fund events
- network with both aspiring and established jazz musicians
- receive a stipend to support the practice of being a musician
- get coaching and mentoring for career development

To take part in this program, you must:

- be a pre-professional jazz musician residing in the Bay Area
- be seriously considering a dedicated career as a jazz musician
- · have a jazz repertoire of at least five tunes that are performed from memory
- be able to improvise on your repertoire and other jazz standards
- be available for performances throughout the 2019-20 academic year
- be available for coaching sessions and rehearsals
- assist with promotion of your Jazz in the Neighborhood events

To apply, send us:

- 1) a completed application form (download or request via email)
- 2) the recommendation form from your teacher or other jazz professional
- 3) link to a video performance of you that includes solo improvisation (or you may schedule an audition)

Applicants who have previously performed at a Jazz in the Neighborhood event need only submit the application form. You may apply at any time, however, to ensure consideration for this year, please submit by October 21, 2019.
